With an interest in research, Dr. Mobini has published articles in peer reviewed journals including the Journal of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery (JOMS). He is also a clinical Instructor at the Department of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery of University of Toronto, Faculty of Dentistry.
